- National Aquarium of NZ fantastic facility with large walk through oceanarium and Blue Penguins too. Swim with the sharks and stingrays if you are real keen (?).
- Waterfront Trails brilliant oceanfront pathways for seaside excursions on our doorstep. Used by all (walkers, runners, skaters, scooters, cyclists, mums and buggys, etc).
- **Bicycle Hire** grab a bike and get into it (we recommend Fish Bike, Napier City Bike Hire or nearby Takaro Traills) or bring your own (we can store them overnight for you in our garage)
- **Bay Skate** one of best skate park facilities in the country. Plenty of hire equipment. Just along Marine Parade.
- Wineries we recommend Church Road, The Mission Estate, Te Awa, Elephant Hill, Clearview, Black Barn and Craggy Range.
- Winery Tours we recommend Vinces World of Wine, Grape Escape, Odyssey and Prinsy's.
- **Golf Courses** two fantastic courses in Napier: Maraenui Golf Course and Waiohiki (or Napier Golf Course) and of course the world-famous Cape Kidnappers Golf Course..
- Playgrounds there's a large public playground on Marine Parade, another in Ahuriri near us.
- Ocean Spa stunning outdoor hot water pool & spa complex. Open until 10pm. Very relaxing.

Hawke's Bay Events

- **Art Deco Weekend** Napier's biggest festival, each year in February. Four action-packed days of dress-ups, cars, planes, steam trains and all things 1930s. There's also a smaller Winter Art Deco weekend in July.
- Winery Concerts The Mission Estate led the way, attracting world-class artists. Church Road Winery and Black Barn also have stunning amphitheatres and attract top-class performers.
- NZ Horse of Year (March). One of the biggest equestrian events in the Southern Hemisphere.
- F.A.W.C Summer (November) and Winter (June). Hawke's Bay's top local food and wine producers showcase their wares over a 2-3 week period. Loads of fun for foodies.
- **The Big Easy** every Easter a big ride to showcase our Hawkes Bay Trails. Starts from Havelock North and ends at Church Road Winery (approx 45km ride) with food and drink to conclude.
- **Park Island** and Hastings Sports Park are now hosting international hockey each year. Also very popular with secondary school Sport competitions (predominantly soccer and hockey).
- **Keirunga Gardens** every Easter and Labour Weekend, visiting enthusiasts bring their steam trains to the Bay for a huge weekend of rides for the kids. A great time if you have little ones.
- Iron Māori now becoming huge event.
- Weddings and conferences due to its central location, great weather and abundance of accommodation, Hawke's Bay has become a popular wedding and conference destination.
